

## GIFT AID DECLARATION

Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, Whitley Bay Baptist Church gets an extra 25 pence from HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC) at no extra cost to yourself. So if you want your donations to go further, Gift Aid them. Just complete this form and return it to the Church Treasurer, Stephen Davidson at Whitley Bay Baptist Church, Park Avenue, Whitley Bay, NE26 1DX.

I want Whitley Bay Baptist Church to treat all donations I have made in the past four years and all donations I make from the date of this declaration, until I notify you otherwise, as Gift Aid donations.

I am a UK taxpayer and understand that if I pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all my donations in that tax year it is my responsibility to pay any difference.

1. You can cancel this Declaration at any time by notifying Whitley Bay Baptist Church.
2. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that Whitley Bay Baptist Church reclaims, you can cancel this Declaration.
3. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return or ask HMRC to adjust your tax code.
4. Please notify the Church Treasurer if you change your name or your address.
